Objectives

The prevention of new and reduction of existing disaster risk in an effort to reduce disaster losses. **Strengthening resilience** through successful multi-hazard disaster risk management.

What is Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR)?

 DRR as a central part of sustainable development. Decades of progress and development may be lost in a few minutes due to the occurrence of natural or man-made hazards.



Policies and practices for DRR should be based on an understanding of disaster risk in all its dimensions of vulnerability, capacity, exposure of persons and assets, hazard characteristics and the environment.

D. Reduce disaster damage to critical infrastructure and disruption of basic services E. Increase the number of countries with national and local disaster risk reduction strategies




F. Substantially enhance international cooperation to developing countries
