









- 400m metric tons produced globally each year
- ~50% of all plastics is SINGLE USE
- <10% is being recycled</p>
- Landfilled, burnt, marine ecosystems



THE PROBLEM



- Plastics from as far as China and Indonesia wash up on our remote archipelago
- Up to 16,000 chemicals in plastics are of concern.
- Health issues caused by additives and residual monomers - cancer, neurodevelopmental issues.
- Health risks for workers engaged in plastic recycling, and disproportionate effect on women & children - cardiovascular, respiratory, hormonal.



Over the Last Three Years

- 320+ tonnes plastic collected
- 22% reduction in recyclable plastics at the landfill
- 300+ tCO2e in GHG emissions reduced or avoided
- \$60,000+ disbursed to 1000+ community members and groups (50% women)
- 80+ youth trained
- 10+ waste pickers are being elevated
